

OCTOBER CHALLENGE: CELEBRATE WITH CONSCIENCE



When hosting celebrations this month, consider making one or two changes to your gatherings that will positively impact the future of all animal life.

THE CHALLENGE

Here are some suggestions:

- Host a meat-free, plant based get-together. This is cost effective, healthy, colorful, helps climate change, reduces waterway pollution, and saves animal lives.
- Opt for something other than single use plastic party goods. Chose to use real dishes or purchase biodegradable options.
- Decorate with reusable items such as fabric garland, live plants, or make your own art. This reduces waste that ultimately harms terrestrial and aquatic landscapes, and animal life.

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
